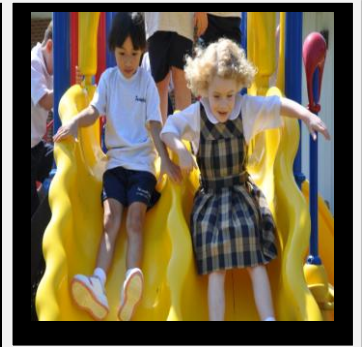

For over 57 years, Portsmouth Catholic Regional School has built upon the rich legacy of Catholic education that began in Portsmouth in 1876. From our earliest days as Little Flower Academy, through our consolidation and re-naming in 1970, to the enhanced technology of today's facility, we remain a proud and storied school that has served generations of families in the Portsmouth, Chesapeake, and Suffolk communities. And thanks to your generosity and support we look with great expectations and excitement to an even brighter future as we continue our mission of Growing Leaders in Christ.

This Annual Report provides a snapshot of our school at the end of our 2010-2011 fiscal year. During this fiscal year we made great advancements in technology, thanks in large measure to a grant from the Beazley Foundation that was supplemented by our initial "Fund An Item" portion of our Spring 2010 Annual Auction. The result was the addition of SMART Boards to all classrooms, which greatly improves student inter-active learning and is a tremendous tool for our teachers.

We also opened our new Science Lab, which is adorned with a beautiful mural created by Mrs. Donna Sievers and Mrs. June Lepski, with additional labor provided by the PCRS Class of 2010. This beautiful learning environment provides our students with greater hands-on science lessons and experiments to enhance classroom instruction in all grades, Pre-K 3 Year Old through Eighth Grade.

This report also captures our first effort at a comprehensive Annual Appeal across our entire PCRS Faith Community- alumni, families, faculty and staff, and friends of PCRS. The results are captured in the pages that follow, and are part of our Development Program. All Catholic schools across the diocese are required to have programs in place that bring in "third source" revenues that supplement tuition and parish subsidies.

What this report does not capture adequately is the countless volunteer hours and tireless efforts of so many of our families and supporters that help sustain this Christ-centered school year after year. It is truly awe inspiring to witness! I cannot thank you enough for your generosity in all of these areas, and I can assure you that our students benefit greatly from all of your efforts.
